Listen, City Dwellers! You should break away from the hustle and bustle of the city and the fumes. So we invite you to spend some time in the bosom of nature. Each of you will do some farm work. And, like real farmers, you will do it all day long. Women will join the Farmers' Wives' Association to learn how to make butter in the churn and flay a heifer. See for yourselves how fast you can go through an obstacle course while wearing wellingtons, size 46. And this is just the beginning....

The game for:

- city dwellers who miss the country life
- groups who want to make their incentive trips more attractive by means of original tasks that build the power of the team
- · people who like having fun with a pinch of salt

Challenge:

For one day, you will become members of the peasant family to acquire subsequent peasant skills together with your foster family. The more skills, the greater probability of winning the first prize – LARGE RAKES.

Challenges concern three areas:

- kitchen "kitchen chores"
- farming "in the homestead"
- agriculture "in the field"

Logistics:

- we recommend particularly a befriended agritourism farm in the Kielce region
- we provide all the necessary materials required for the task
- due to its character, the programme cannot be carried out between late autumn and early spring

Advantages:

 integration of the team members who do not know one another very well or have been working together for a short time

- freeing positive emotions and looking at yourself from a distance
- test yourself as a leader or in another team role
- a great deal of humour and good fun

Variants / Extensions:

- competitions can be modified depending on the customer needs; the bravest ones can even try loading "manure" on the cart
- a feast prepared in a regional style with folk songs and mental skill games
- the game can complement a training session in team building or managerial competencies
- a coaching part during which the participants' attitude to new tasks and their readiness to move beyond the patterns can be discussed, in a group or individually

The game through the eyes of the participants:
