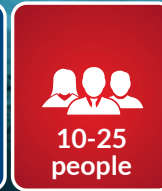

- **The game for:**
 - thrilling story lovers
 - those interested in the Polish folklore
 - groups for whom integration is something more than just paintball and feedback sessions in a training room
- **Challenge:**

You will become a television crew that has come to Poland to take a closer look at the story about the witch. Take matters into your own hands and set off to see to what extent the information about her terrible deeds is true. Like in the cult film Blair Witch, take your video cameras and follow the four foreign students who disappeared a few days ago. Beware and – according to what you have heard in the village of Zubrzyca about the habits of this famous witch – record anything that you think is important. On your route, you will find a lot of traces that will help you find out what has happened to the young tourists.

Do not be taken in, do not veer off course. Let your imagination guide you. Maybe you will solve this mystery, but it is far more likely that you will only be able to present the hypothesis about what exactly has happened to the young boys. The evening show of your movies and the time around the campfire while sharing the stories you have heard on your way will be something you will remember for a long time...
- **Foundation:**
 - integration on the basis of a very interesting plot and “powerful” sensations
 - developing imagination, vigilance and a sense of observation
- **Logistics:**
 - due to weather conditions, the programme is conducted between April and October
