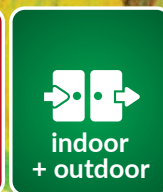




ARTEVENTIN FRONT OF THE WAWEL CASTLE

Let's get it started!

Is there still anyone yet who does not know yet that Krakow is not only the Wawel Castle and the Mariacka Tower, but also the capital of Polish art? Maybe we do not have Montmartre or the gallery like MoMa in New York, but this city is full of artists and creative atmosphere. Join it! Paint something with us! Let's get it started!

The game for:

- sensitive people, aesthetes, art connoisseurs...
- ...but also for those who have been resistant to art so far – it is time to break the ice!
- those ready for colourful experiments, having fun with photography, painting and graffiti
- those interested in Polish culture and art
- those bored with the mainstream “sightseeing”, ready to get to know Krakow through creative activities

Challenge:

Krakow reveals its atelier. Using a storeroom filled with costumes and props, reproduce the scenes from the most famous paintings you can see in Krakow. To choose the paintings you would like to reproduce, first we will invite you to the Krakow Museum where you will be able to have a closer look at the world-renowned masterpieces. Send a funny postcard to your friends, depicting you as a lady with an ermine (according to the popular painting by Leonardo da Vinci, found in the Krakow museum). Have fun with famous Polish cut-outs. Create graffiti with your logo and the Wawel Dragon. If you become tired – drink tea at the museum café and – feeling regenerated by its wonderful aroma – make stained glass similar to the works by Wyspiański (Ups, you do not know Wyspiański? All the more!). Finally, reflect all your emotions and impressions from your visit in Krakow in one large cloth by means of the action painting technique. This painting will be a souvenir and at the same time it can decorate your office.

Foundation:

- getting to know Poland through its culture
- integration in action and projects conducted together

Logistics:

We provide all the necessary tools, accessories and costumes required for the programme. For the purposes of the painting reproduction, we employ a photographer and rent the costumes from the epoch. During the event, it is necessary to rent a training room (unless the weather allows for acting in the open air).

Advantages:

- mish-mash of colours – getting to know Krakow through culture and art
- great fun that develops a creative world view
- effective integration – group work has never brought such beautiful results!

Variants / Extensions:

Are you interested in the art of a specific time period, a specific region of Poland or maybe you want to look for the influence of your domestic art on Polish culture? We will change any of your suggestions into a creative task. The programme can also include taking a virtual tour of the Krakow galleries or meeting a representative of the Krakow artistic environment. Of course, you will take a beautifully framed photo of your reproduced painting with you!
